

Blackwood River Valley

Farmland, Bridgetown

The Blackwood River is the longest continually flowing river in Western Australia at 270kms long. It's a popular river for water activities such as canoeing and a great backdrop for a family picnic. Boyup Brook, Balingup, Nannup, Bridgetown and Greenbushes are the beautiful towns that make up this countryside region. Visitors will be mesmerised by the stunning scenery. Lush green rolling hills give way to the river's wide pools and rushing rapids. Late winter to spring, the valley comes alive with flowers and visitors rush in to see the many award-winning gardens displaying brightly coloured tulips and daffodils

NANNUP

Situated on the banks of the Blackwood River, Nannup is a historic mill town surrounded by forests. The scenery is especially beautiful in spring when the wildflowers burst into colour. There are a number of walks that take visitors along the river and into Kondil Park to appreciate the spectacle. Restaurants, cafés and wineries provide a warm welcome for visitors to this attractive town.

There's plenty of adventure all year round with canoeing and it's a great place to base yourself to take on a section of the Munda Biddi mountain bike trail.

It is known as the 'Garden Village' in honour of its many beautiful gardens and its garden festivals, most notable being the annual Flower and Garden Festival in mid-August which centres on Nannup's famous tulips. Be sure to also check out the Lavender which flowers from November to January. On the March long weekend every year, Nannup will host its annual music festival which will attract local and international artists who will perform across six venues.

BRIDGETOWN

With a relaxed country atmosphere, Bridgetown has a delightful rustic charm and serenity. Its special character extends to the breathtaking views of the town and its surrounding green rolling hills, tall jarrah and marri forests.

Bridgetown comes alive every November with the famous Blues at Bridgetown Festival that attracts thousands of music fans. Bridgetown offers a vast array of unique arts and crafts that can be viewed in the local shops and at the distinctive Jigsaw Gallery where hundreds of jigsaw puzzles have been collected since the 1950s, the only collection of its kind in the Southern Hemisphere. The changing seasons have a truly beautiful effect on this Blackwood River Valley town. Experience enchanting misty mornings in winter, refreshingly cool summer nights, a blaze of colour through the deciduous trees in autumn and bursts of new colour in spring. Gardens are open during the 'Festival of Country Gardens' in autumn and spring.

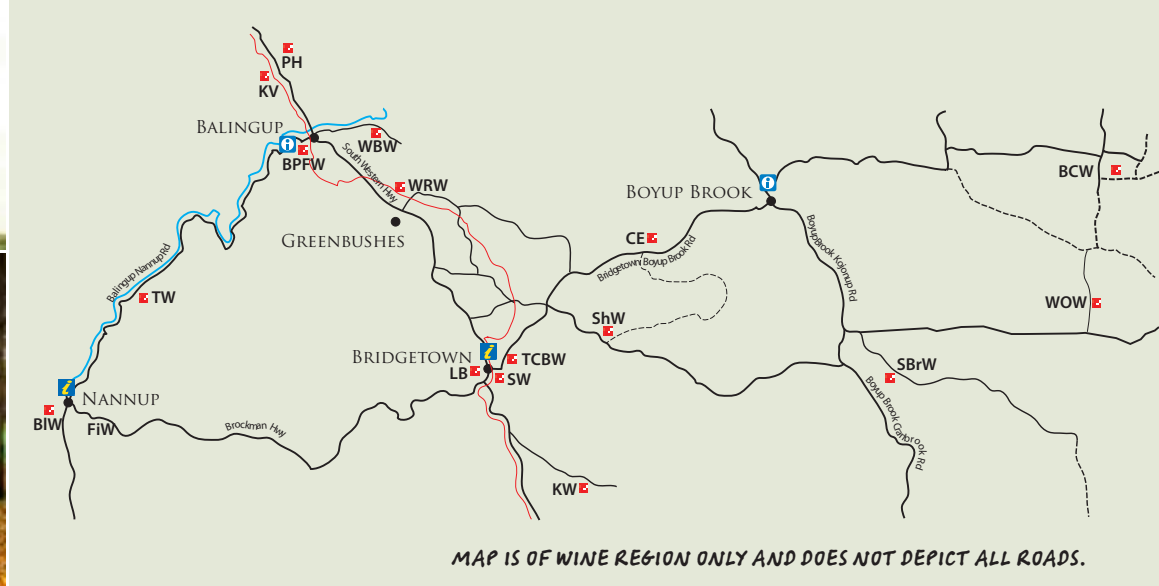

BALINGUP

Balingup sits at the northern entrance to the Blackwood River Valley, surrounded by undulating hills, forests and orchards. This charmingly beautiful small town is steadily becoming known for its locally handcrafted pottery, herbal products, arts and crafts, annual open gardens, festivals and concerts. Balingup is home to the scarecrow, which is outfitted differently according to the festival that's on in town such as the Balingup Medieval Carnivale, held in August every year.

Spend an interesting hour or two wandering its many specialty shops and galleries before stopping at a quaint café. The sixty hectare Golden Valley Tree Park holds a unique collection of beautiful and interesting trees from all over the world. A great place for a picnic, with several walk trails through the park including the Bibbulmun Track.

Be sure to take The Golden Triangle drive, a truly stunning scenic 100km drive of meandering road that forms a triangle from Balingup, Bridgetown and Nannup through magnificent scenery, much of it along the banks of the Blackwood River.

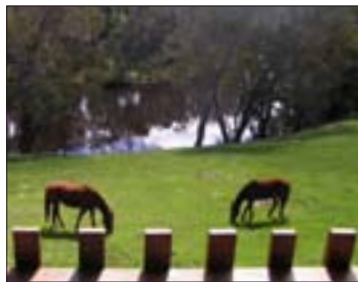

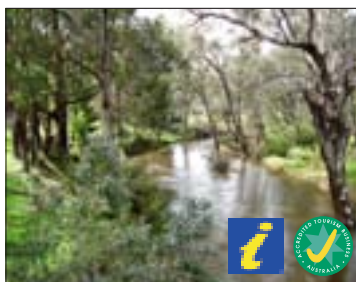
